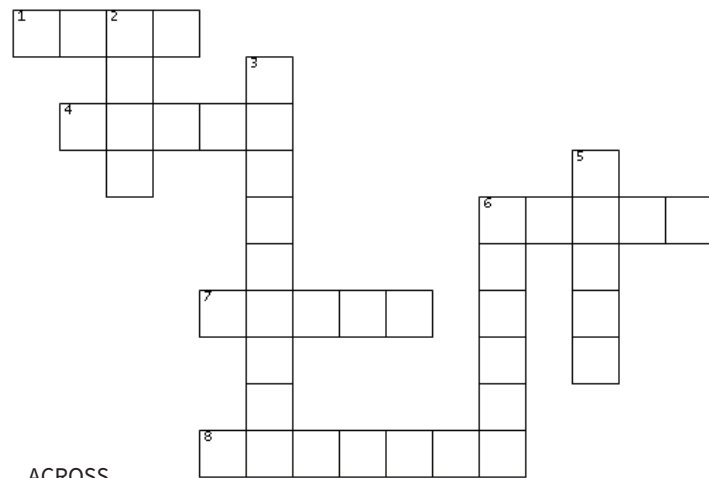

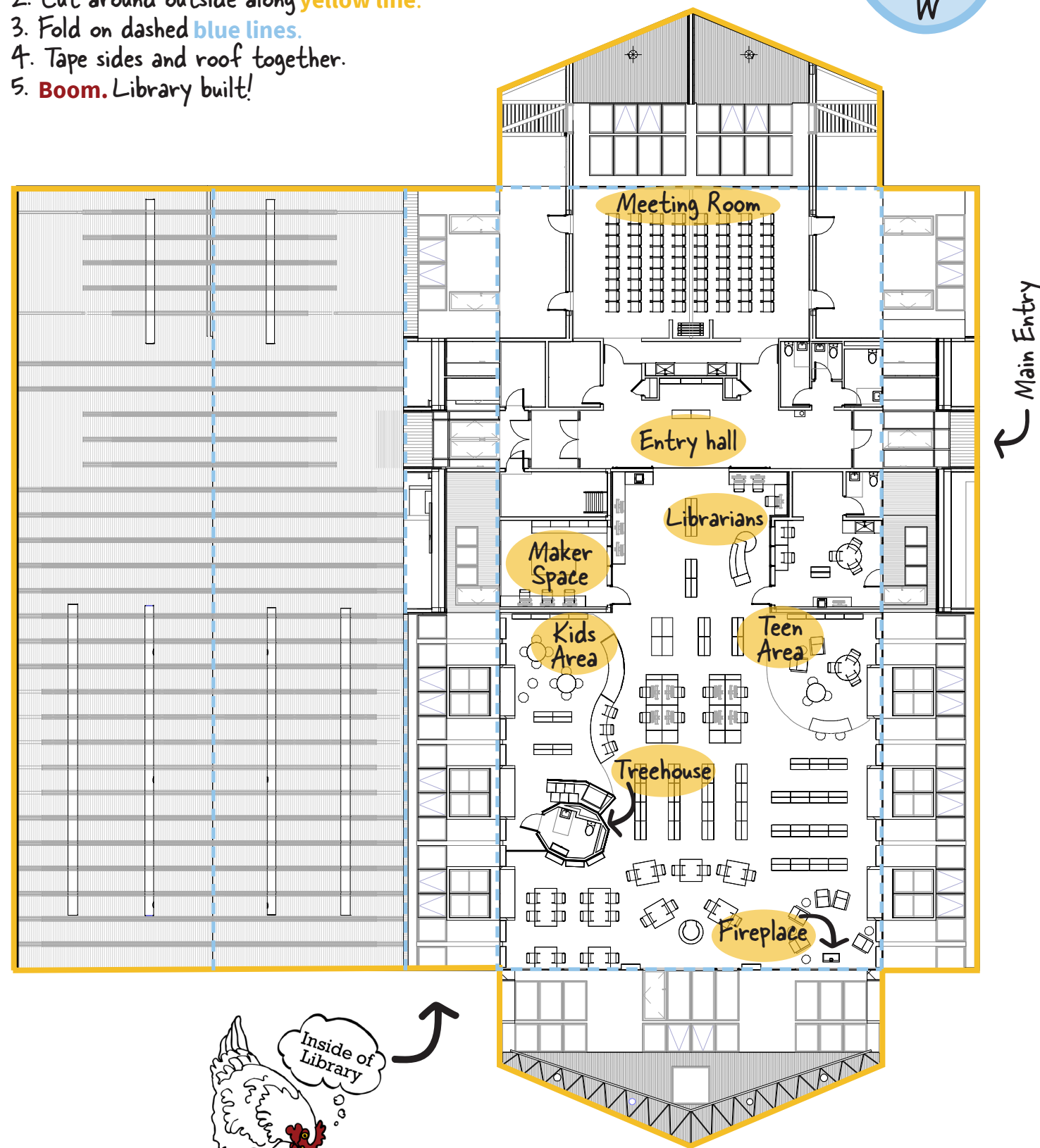
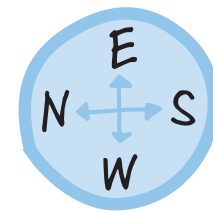
- Andrew Carnegie** donated \$1.6 billion (in today's dollars) to open 2,509 libraries worldwide between 1886 to 1919.
- Our new library will have a view of **Mount Gardner** from its west-facing windows. There will also be an **outdoor library** on the west side that helps people learn about firewise plantings.
- Libraries use the **Dewey** Decimal System to organize books.
- Dr. **Suess**, the famous children's **author**, is the second richest dead person!
- Mr. **Walter Frisbee** came to the Methow Valley in 1898 and he ran the Valley's first **lending library** from his homestead, which included the site of our new library! Later, Mrs. **Painter** hosted the library in her home on **Lower Bear Creek Road**. The Winthrop library has had five different homes and the new library will be its sixth.
- The library will have a charging station for **electric** cars.
- The library will have a **maker space** room for making cool things like robots and art.
- FOWL** is the acronym of the group creating, funding and building the new library. It's also another word for chicken! Over 625 Friends of the Winthrop Public Library (FOWL) have donated money to help build the new library.
- The **Susie Stephens** Trail runs right next to the new library. This trail is for bikes and pedestrians, and it starts in Winthrop at the Spring Creek Bridge that crosses the Methow River.
- The Winthrop librarian's name is **Ree**. In Twisp, **Dawn** is the librarian. Both Ree and Dawn love story time with little kids!
